On Saturday, September 10, 2011 the Sparks Masonic Building Association (SMBA) will be hosting a “Burger and Beans” BBQ at the Building. This will be for an unveiling of the recently restored Masonic Sign, which for many years designated the Wadsworth Lodge on “B” Street downtown Sparks. The sign, which was removed from the old building downtown, had been installed upon the roof of the Pyramid Building in its original condition; however, it had deteriorated significantly from exposure to the elements over the years. The SMBA has had it restored and remounted out of respect for Wadsworth Lodge’s historic presence within the community and so that, once again, it would properly designate a Temple of Free Masonry for the entire community to view.

This event, though, not as historically significant as the laying of a cornerstone is, however, singular in its historic importance to the Craft in Nevada. All Masons and their families are cordially invited to attend the unveiling and the BBQ to follow. The cost will be ten dollars a person, the proceeds going to the Operating Fund for the Sparks Masonic Building. This is not only a Wadsworth Lodge event but it is a General Masonic Event and all Masons who can be present are encouraged to set aside this time to observe and participate in this historic event.
