"FROM GRAND LODGE"

Early February marked the first annual Nevada Masonic Leadership Conference in Las Vegas. This conference was well attended, with approximately 110 Brothers attending all or part of the conference. The format is a 2 1/2 day seminar (Friday evening, Saturday, and Sunday) with break-out sessions and general informational topics. General topics include: Grand Lodge Structure, Grand Lodge Communications with Lodges, Using the Nevada Masonic Code, Investigations, Red Book Program, and the Nevada Mentoring Program. Break-out sessions for Senior Wardens, Junior Wardens, Deacons, Treasurers & Trustees, and Secretaries provide specific information that will help the Brothers sitting in these offices perform their duties better, and help prepare them for increased responsibilities. The topics are too numerous to mention here. I attended the Las Vegas conference, and there were many comments about the quality of the information & presentations, that this kind of seminar has been needed for a long time, and how those Brothers would benefit from attending. The cost to register is \$35.00 in advance, or \$45.00 at the door, and includes 6 meals (including the Saturday evening dinner with Wives or significant others), a very large manual with 500 plus pages of reference material, a 1 gig zip drive loaded with all of the reference material & Power Point presentations, the Nevada Mentor's Manual, Red Book, and other info, plus all of the training & knowledge shared during the seminar. I strongly encourage all of the Lodge officers plus all interested Master Masons attend this conference in Reno, April 6, 7, and 8. Since this would normally be our Stated meeting in April, we will discuss options at the March 1st stated meeting. Our officer group and Wadsworth Lodge will benefit greatly by having them attend this seminar. See the Secretary for registration materials. You will not regret it.

Also, please mark your calendars for the May 3rd Stated meeting when our Grand Master, MW Richard M. (Mike) Hoaglin comes to Wadsworth #25 for his official visitation. He brings a very important message that all Brothers will benefit from. That weekend (Saturday May 4th) will also be the "Grand Master's Ladies Appreciation Dinner" hosted at the Kerak Shrine Temple. This will be a "Cinco de Mayo" themed dinner in honor of all of our Ladies. Please watch for the flyers and registration materials which will be out very soon. More information to follow next month.
