Well in an effort to step into his shadow, here I go.

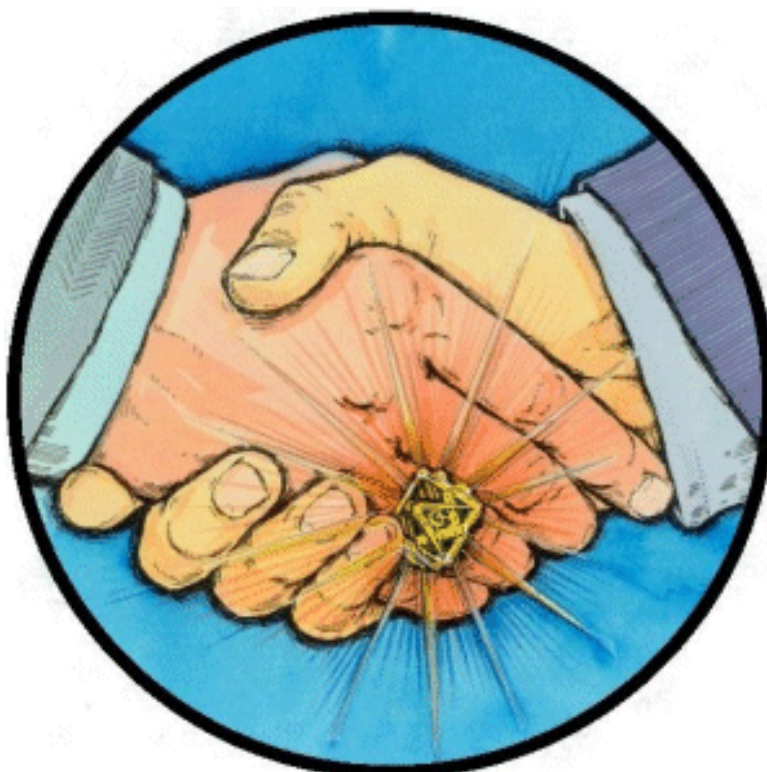
